The AAUW January meeting and program was held in the Presbyterian meeting room beginning at 9:30 a.m. on Saturday, January 12<sup>th</sup>. There were fourteen women in attendance. Refreshments were served by Wanda, Debby, and Sue.

For the program part of the meeting, Charlene Chase showed a dvd that gave background information having to do with the book *Half the Sky*. The title comes from a Mao Tse-tung quote, "Women hold up half the sky." The presentation dealt with the exploitation of women (sexually and otherwise), their educational and economical deprivation, and the cruelty dealt them in some countries.

A discussion followed the presentation about women helping women. Some money, \$500, coming from the women's celebration will be donated to Kiva for women to start their own businesses. Then they pay the money back which keeps the money circulating to help other women. We will give our money to the state AAUW to disperse.

The theme of our women's celebration event is *International Women Helping Women*.
